

FBC-ENID Behavior Agreement

Conduct Behavior, Procedures, and Rules

- 1. CELL PHONES**– Bringing your cell phone is discouraged. If you bring one, you will need to check it in when you check-in at church. We will have free times throughout the day that you may use your cell phone. They will not be available after lights out or for alarm use. Many churches are banning cell phones altogether; this is gracious. All cell phones will be returned to students for the bus ride home. Any misuse of cell phones during the camp is subject to confiscation until your return home.
- 2. ATTIRE**-Falls Creek is a Christian church camp and so modesty is enforced. Swimsuits must be covered up with a dark t-shirt to and from the swimming location. Shorts should have a 5 inch length inseam or longer; a four-inch from ground/kneeling or longer for skirts. Slits in dresses should not go above the knee. No stomach-bearing shirts are allowed. NO Tank tops. Spaghetti straps are not allowed. Compression shorts, Leggings-type clothing must be covered up by modest shorts (5 inch inseam or longer), etc.
- 3. MEDICINE**-All medications should be marked with the campers name and *parents'* dosage instructions. Please turn these in at check-in at the church. We have one assigned sponsor/cabin nurse who will take care of medicine.
- 4. CURFEW**-FBC Enid curfew is 10:00pm each evening. Students must be in the cabin by that time.
- 5. NO ALARM CLOCKS**-We will ensure that all students are awakened in time for breakfast.
- 6. NO PRANKS/CONTRABAND**– Pranks will not be tolerated. Fireworks, shaving cream, etc are not allowed at Falls Creek.
- 7. NO PDA**– Public Displays of Affection are inappropriate at Falls Creek. It's a great time to meet new friends, but leave the holding hands, mushy-gushy stuff out of it. Violation of Falls Creek PDA is grounds for automatic dismissal from camp and parents will responsible for picking up their student.
- 8. MONEY**– It is suggested that students not bring large amounts of money to Falls Creek. Enough to cover lunch on the way down, snacks on the way back, and a couple ices a day will be plenty.
- 9. FAMILY GROUPS**– Students will be required to participate in all Family Group activities, including KP and Bathroom Duty. Students should tell their Family Group leader or any other adult sponsor if they need to leave the Tabernacle service and will be accompanied by a same-sex adult.

If a student is not compliant with the Falls Creek and FBC Enid conduct behavior, procedures, or rules, and the Falls Creek or FBC Enid staff/sponsors see the need to send the camper home, I (we) understand it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the student to pick up the student at the parent/guardian's expense.
