

Dear parents and students,

As school wraps up and summer draws near it is important to finalize summer plans. One of our main focuses in summer is Falls Creek Camp. This year the theme is Mystery and we will be attending July 1<sup>st</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>. This is an incredible time for the students, and I encourage students to make this a priority in their schedules. As with any activity of this magnitude, there are important details that you the parents and students need to be aware of. 1. Camp this year is going to cost \$100. This money is due before students leave for camp. There are two opportunities for students to earn scholarships for camp. The first way to earn a scholarship, a student must **read the book *Disciplines for a Godly Life* and turn in a 1-page typed book report.** This report must be submitted to me a week before we leave for camp and if completed will cover the entirety of camp for the student. The second way a student can earn scholarship is by **bringing a friend to camp.** If a student is a member and brings a friend who is not a member of our church, I will give both the student and their friend \$25 towards camp. This will stack if students bring multiple friends.
2. In this envelope you will find forms for camp. These forms should be completed and turned into the church office as soon as possible and no later than **Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup>**. If a student is bringing a friend, they should obtain a form from the West End or the church office for their friend to complete. Also, because of new policies in place, any student who turns 18 on, or before, June 6<sup>th</sup> must have a background check on file. These can be obtained from the church office and must be returned before **Sunday, June 16<sup>th</sup>** to guarantee that they are completed in time for camp. All forms should be turned into the church office.
3. Parents are important to the success of our student camp. To facilitate understanding of what our policies and procedures will be for camp, all students will be required to have a parent or guardian present for a **mandatory parent meeting Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.** If a student does not have a parent or guardian present at this meeting, they will not be able to attend camp. This is an important detail to communicate to any friends your child may be inviting. If there is a conflict and none of a student's parents or guardians are able to attend this parent meeting, the parents or guardians need to contact me by Wednesday June 19<sup>th</sup> to make arrangements to pick up necessary information.

I am excited to experience my first ever summer camp at Falls Creek. I cannot wait to see how God works through both our students and leaders. I encourage you to begin praying for all the students and adults who will use our cabin this summer and specifically for those who go with our church.
